## ABOUT COMPASSION COALITION

### A Self-Sustaining Nonprofit Ecosystem

Compassion Coalition operates a national logistics and nonprofit retail system designed to move surplus food and essential goods into communities where access is limited.

In 2025, more than \$100+ million in food and essential resources have been distributed through Compassion Coalition's national network of nonprofit partners, reaching more than 5.7 million individuals.

The model integrates large-scale product sourcing, centralized distribution, and nonprofit grocery operations. Revenue generated through grocery markets is reinvested directly into charitable distribution and partner support, allowing the system to expand without relying solely on donations or external funding.

In 2025, as many nonprofit organizations faced reductions in public funding and program support, Compassion Coalition continued increasing distribution volume and expanding its partner network.

Because the organization operates through a self-sustaining model and does not carry institutional debt, it remains stable and able to scale distribution even during periods of broader resource constraints.



#### How the Distribution Model Works

- Large-scale product recovery from manufacturers, distributors, and national suppliers
- Centralized warehousing and high-volume distribution across a national partner network
- Nonprofit grocery markets providing consistent access to low-cost food at the community level
- Revenue reinvested directly into distribution, logistics, and partner support



## HOW WE DELIVER IMPACT

#### National Resource Distribution Network

Compassion Coalition delivers surplus food and essential goods through a national distribution system serving a network of nonprofit partners.

In 2025 to date, more than \$100+ million in food and essential resources have been distributed, reaching over 5.7 million individuals through a national network of nonprofit partners.

This is continuous distribution supported by logistics infrastructure operating daily across partner networks.

#### Bargain Grocery — Nonprofit Grocery Model

Bargain Grocery operates nonprofit grocery markets in food deserts, providing consistent access to low-cost food while reinvesting revenue directly into charitable distribution.

- 256,000+ annual transactions across both locations
- Approximately 25% of purchases are made using SNAP/EBT benefits
- 25% of customers are refugees

#### Community Resource Center For Nonprofits & Their Clients

Since launching in December 2025, the center has already served 50 nonprofit partners. CCRC provides access to new, brand-name shoes, clothing, and small home essentials for:

- Foster families and children
- Individuals reentering the workforce following rehabilitation
- Households in transition

Designed to equip nonprofit partners with consistent, high-quality goods for direct distribution within their communities.

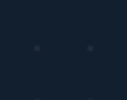

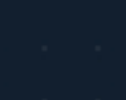

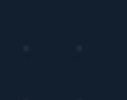

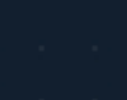

## IN 2025, BARGAIN GROCERY RECORDED:

256,000 Transactions  
25% using SNAP/EBT

\$100 at Bargain Grocery = \$438 at national retail chains

During SNAP/EBT reductions and federal funding disruptions, an additional 10% discount was applied to help families maintain access to food.



## BARGAIN GROCERY

### A Low-Cost Nonprofit Grocery Model

Bargain Grocery operates nonprofit grocery markets in food deserts, providing consistent access to affordable food while expanding household purchasing power and reinvesting revenue directly into charitable distribution. With more than 25 years of operation, the model demonstrates sustained demand and long-term viability in underserved communities.

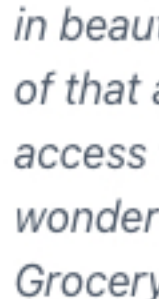
The stores generated 256,000 transactions, serving thousands of households and expanding purchasing power through pricing that targets 30% or more below major retailers. At this level of discount, a \$100 grocery basket equates to approximately \$438 at traditional big-box stores.

In 2025, approximately 25% of Bargain Grocery transactions were made using EBT/SNAP benefits, reflecting the store's role in supporting households experiencing food insecurity. Reductions in SNAP benefits and federal funding disruptions placed additional strain on low-income families during the year. In response, an additional 10% discount was applied on top of standard pricing to help stabilize access to food during periods of heightened financial pressure.

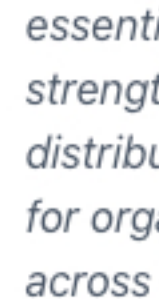

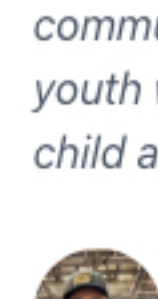

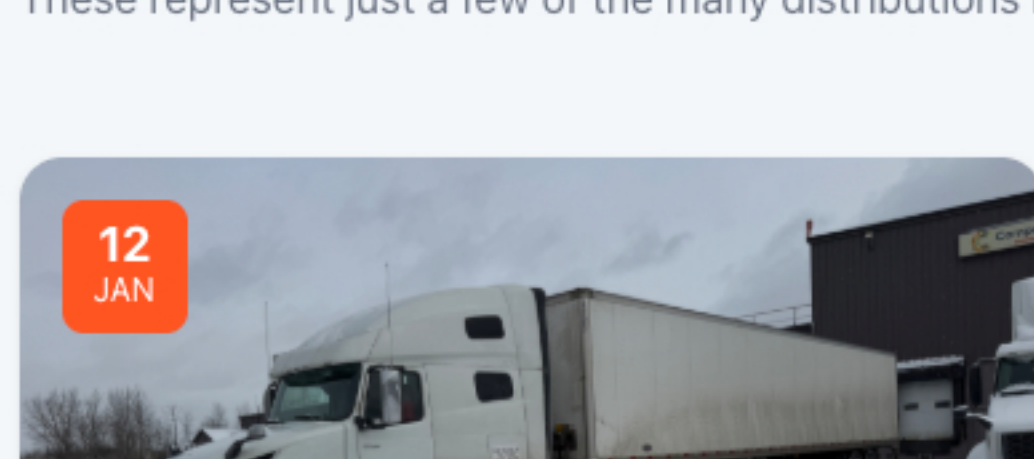

These represent just a few of the many distributions made across the Northeast and throughout the United States in 2025.

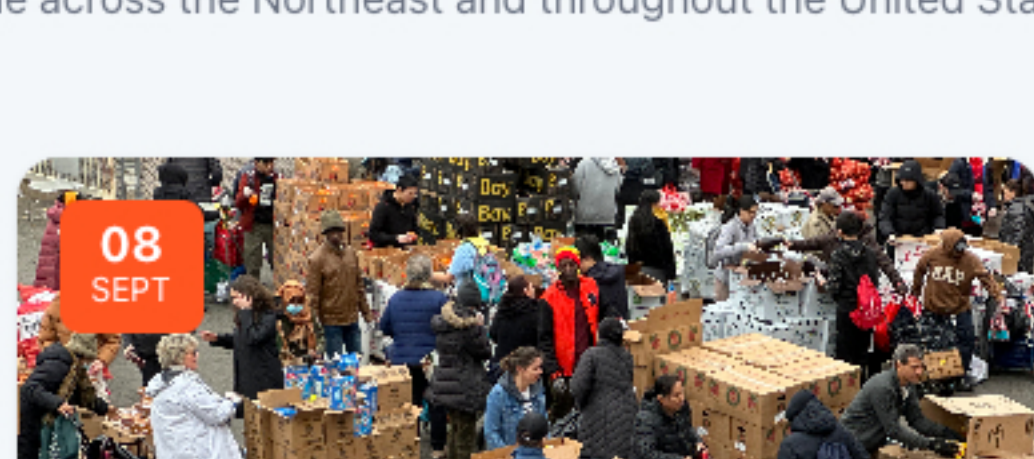


12 JAN
